Between February 8, 2009 and April 2, 2010, the Boy Scouts of America accepted nominations for the Centennial Hall of Leadership. Scouters could submit an essay through Scouting.org to nominate living, youth or adult members of the BSA that have made an impact on their lives.

Thousands of nominations have been made, including 38 Scouts or Scouters from our council. This month national Committees will review the nominees, and finalists will be selected from councils and then each region of the BSA. The final national Hall of Leadership will be announced at the National Scout Jamboree and in local councils during the Shining Light Celebration.
